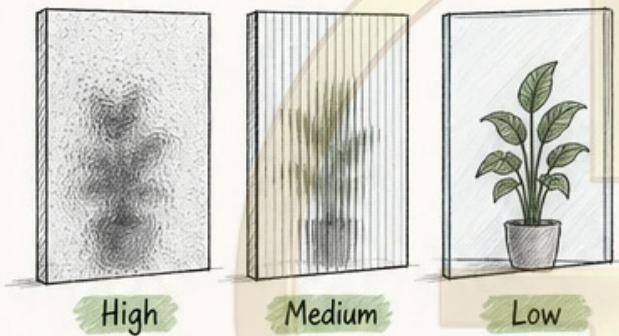

2 NATURAL LIGHT

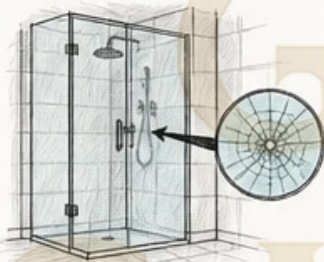


Choose a glass that diffuses light while maintaining the desired level of brightness.

3 DESIGN STYLE

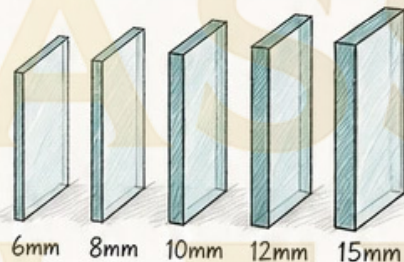


4 SAFETY

- ☐ Is safety glass required?
- ☐ Have I finalized the hardware?
- ☐ Is the selected texture easy to maintain?
- ☐ Have accurate site measurements been taken?
- ☐ Does the glass complement my furniture and finishes?
- ☐ Have I consulted a professional before placing the order?

- ☐ Edge finish selected
- ☐ Site conditions reviewed
- ☐ Installation drawings approved
- ☐ Safety standards complied with

INSTALLATION & MAINTENANCE



Ensuring Long Term Performance

During Installation

- a. Handle glass carefully using protective equipment.
- b. Avoid direct contact between glass and metal.
- c. Use approved hardware and accessories.
- d. Maintain proper expansion gaps.
- e. Verify alignment before final fixing.

Maintenance Tips

- ✓ Clean using a microfiber cloth.
- ✓ Use a mild glass cleaner.
- ✓ Clean hardware periodically.
- ✓ Wipe away moisture regularly in wet areas.

Avoid

- ✗ Abrasive cleaning pads
- ✗ Acidic or harsh chemicals
- ✗ Impact on glass corners and edges
- ✗ Dragging heavy objects against the glass

COMMON MISTAKES TO AVOID



Small Errors Can Lead to Costly Replacements

Avoid these common mistakes during planning and installation

- ✗ Choosing glass before selecting hardware
- ✗ Incorrect thickness selection
- ✗ Ignoring privacy requirements
- ✗ Not considering safety glass where required
- ✗ Incorrect measurements
- ✗ Poor installation practices
- ✗ Pattern orientation mistakes
- ✗ Delaying site measurements until fabrication

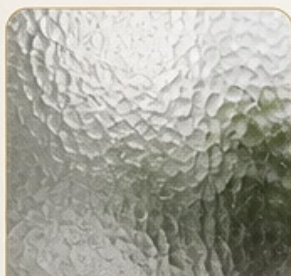
